## Key Vocabulary

Ballad

A song which tells a story - similar to a poem.

Compose

To create an original piece of music.

Stanza

A short section of text, sometimes known as a verse in a song or poem.

Solo

Performing alone.

Ensemble

A small group of musicians who perform together.

Expression

Making your thoughts or feelings known when

reading, singing or performing.

The words in a song.


Repeated section of music with the same tune and lyrics.

Nonsense
Words which have no meaning and are often used for filling time in songs - e.g. 'la', 'do', 'oooh'.

Ballads are songs which tell a story. They can be in many styles, such as pop and musical theatre and were used in ancient times to carry news and legends across countries.
