

Key Vocabulary

Rhythm A pattern of long and short notes. The different instruments, rhythms or melodies Layers that build the overall texture. Melody An arrangement of notes which sound tuneful. Dynamics The volume of the music (loud or quiet). Timbre The quality of sound e.g. smooth, scratchy, twinkly. Pitch How high or low a sound is. A repeated section of a song that usually has Verse different words (lyrics) each time it is repeated. A repeated section of a song that usually has Chorus the same words (lyrics) each time it is repeated.




