Dear Parent/Carers

Firstly, we would like to thank you for all the support you have given school over the last week. It has been an extremely tough time and we appreciate your kind words and help to maintain safety for all our school community.

As a school, we have been lucky to have the support of PHE, St Helens Health and Safety and the LA to help us to further control the recent COVID outbreak. We have been commended for everything we have already put in place to combat the outbreak; however, we are still getting new daily cases.

On Monday 22nd November, St Aidan's will have a Mobile Testing Unit onsite. This unit will enable parents to take their child/ren for a PCR test. The onsite unit will be available between 2pm – 6pm. To help with the testing, parents will be able to collect their child from 2pm by the outside classroom doors. This is to ensure families can maintain social distancing and help with a steady flow. The facility will be available until 6pm so accessible after school also for our children. We urge for all our children to be tested to help further control this outbreak.
