



Dear Parents/Carers,

I am Police Community Support Officer Jonathan Mitchell-Chard for Billinge and Garswood. It has come to my attention that the parking situation at St Aidan's has become dangerous. Due to this being reported not only to the school but to the police as well, me and my colleagues will be attending the school at drop off/pick up times to monitor the situation. You are NOT allowed to stop on the yellow zigzags between the times of 08:00 and 17:00 and will be monitored by our partners in the Parking Service at St Helens Council. If you park on the pedestrian walkway NOT leaving enough room for wheelchair access/ pram access, then under regulation 3 of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986 I will either ticket or remove said vehicle as it is in a position causing obstruction or danger to persons using the road. This is also used if you are parked on bends not leaving 10 meters at the entrance of the junction. I will also, apply this to any vehicle, blocking a vehicle that is on a driveway as you are preventing it from accessing the highway.
