AUTUMN TERM PARENTS' EVENING 'Meet The Teacher Night' (Nursery to Y6)

Our Meet the Teacher Night this term will take place on Wednesday the 16th of October 2019.

The classrooms will be open from 3.30pm - 6.30pm and your child's books will be available for you to have an in depth look through. May we take this opportunity to highlight just how important the children's workbooks are to us and to the children. The workbooks are also scrutinised during an inspection period as they are an excellent way of showing the progress that a child has made over time. At this point in the academic year, the teachers will have very little 'data' to share with you and this would be the wrong forum to share this information. We have planned a more formal Parents' Evening in March where you will meet your child's class teacher and they will talk to you about their academic progress. The meeting on Wednesday is more about how your child has settled in and if they are happy. However, as you are aware St Aidan's has a completely open door policy and therefore the teachers are available all year round should you have any concerns about your child's progress.

Mrs Lowe (School Business Manager) will be giving all teachers data collection sheets for each child from Y1 to Y6. We would like you to update these before you leave as it is so important that school have all the correct, accurate information for your child.
