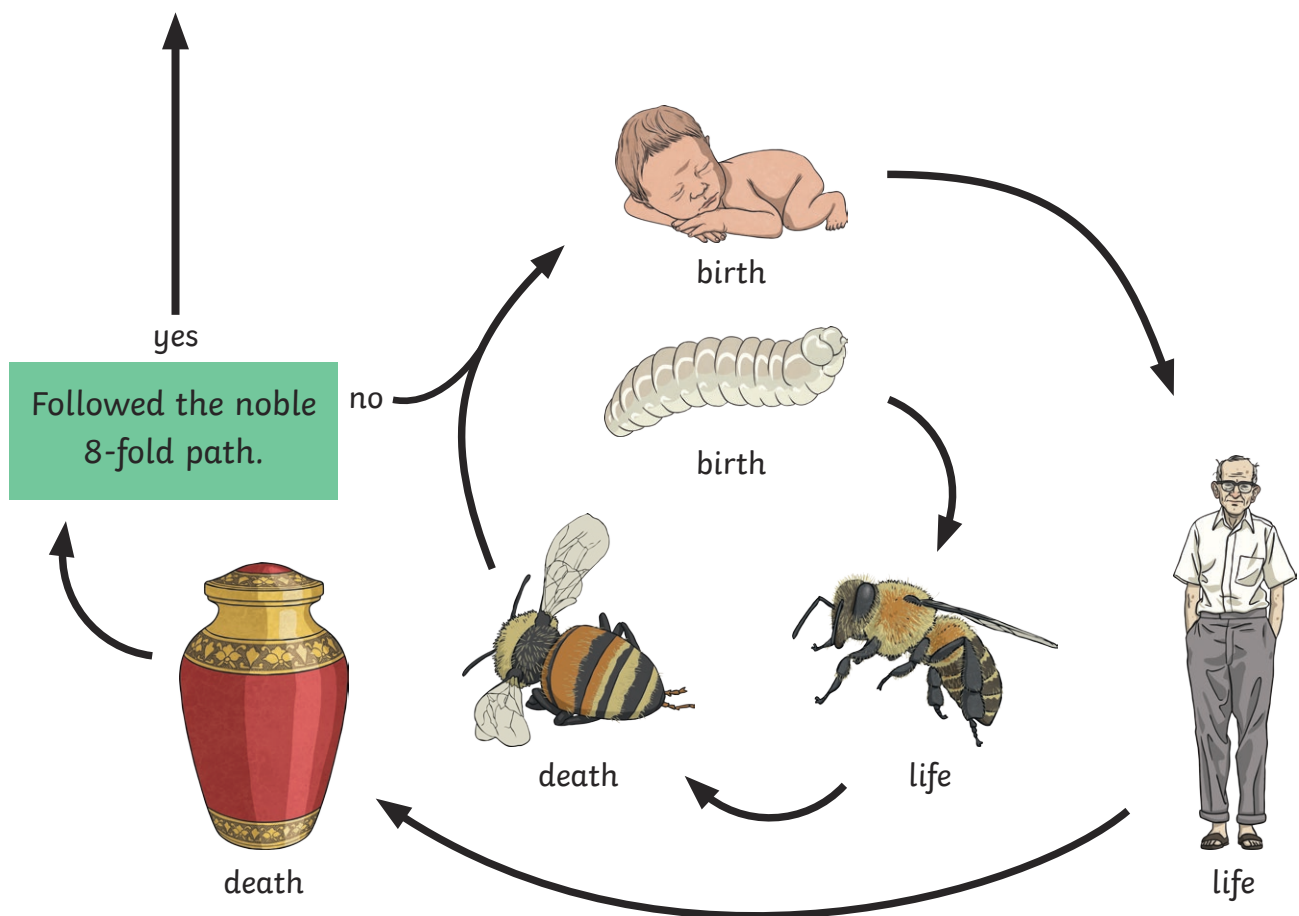


# Reincarnation and Emancipation

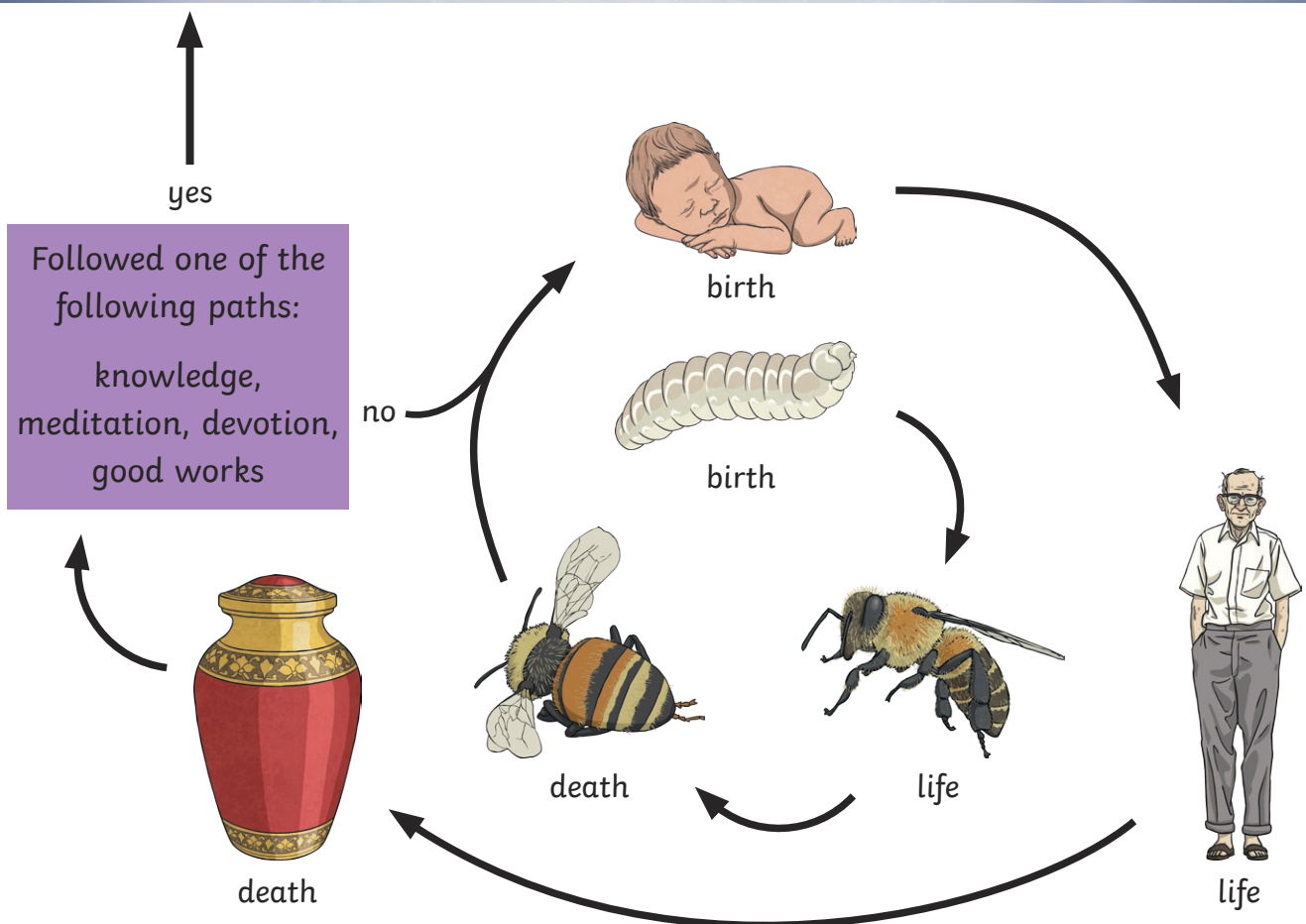
# Reincarnation and Emancipation
