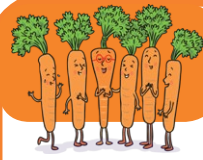




What type of vegetable is Sally?

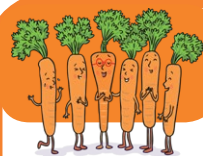

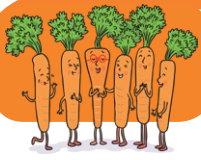

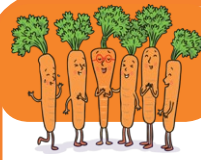
